

## BIBLIOGRAPHY

INFORMATION on the subject-matter of this book is to be found in numerous histories of individual parishes and their churches, in the vast material of parochial records and registers, in the considerable number of books which deal with various aspects of parochial life and interest, in ecclesiastical laws and canons, and to a limited extent in Church histories.
