WELCOME The Moderator welcomed Mrs A Pringle to her first meeting of Presbytery

AUTHORITY TO MEET There was laid on the table the minute of 6 May, appointing this day for the establishment of the linkage between Kilmory and Lamlash and for the induction of the Revd Gillean P Maclean.

INDUCTION The Presbytery then proceeded to the Church, the Revd James McNay conducted worship. The Clerk gave a brief narrative of the proceedings in the matter of the linkage of Kilmory and Lamlash and the call to Revd Gillean Maclean. The congregations having answered satisfactorily the questions put to them, the Moderator declared the linkage between the two congregations to be established. The Moderator then put to Revd Gillean Maclean the questions required to be answered on induction, and she signed the formula and he then inducted Revd Gillean Maclean to the charge of Kilmory linked with Lamlash, and gave her the right hand of fellowship as did members of Presbytery present. Thereafter the Revd Dr Johnston McKay addressed Revd Gillean Maclean and the congregation and preached the sermon.

The Presbytery retired to the hall where the Clerk was instructed to add Revd Gillean Maclean's name to the Roll of Presbytery, to send certified intimation of the induction to the Session Clerks of Kilmory and Lamlash and to the Council of Ministries.. Those officiating were thanked by Mr W F Turner on behalf of Presbytery. Mr Alan Saunderson and Revd Angus Adamson were warmly thanked for their services as Interim Moderator at Lamlash and Kilmory respectively and discharged from these duties.
