BUSINESS: Following intimation of arrangements presbytery joined the congregation for public worship led and conducted at appropriate stages by Revs Mackay and Robertson and during which an apposite sermon was delivered by Rev Mackay.

The preamble to proceedings was read by the clerk pro-tem and thereafter the moderator put the relevant question to members of the congregation who confirmed their unanimous assent to union by standing whereupon the moderator made a statement of dedication and pronounced the congregations of Kilwinning Mansefield Trinity and Fergushill to have been united under the name of Kilwinning Mansefield Trinity. The Moderator then put the relevant question to Rev Andrew Robertson who re-affirmed adherence to the vows taken when inducted to the charge of Kilwinning Mansefield Trinity whereupon the moderator declared him to be minister of the newly united charge of the same name.

In conclusion the moderator thanked all who had attended and assisted in the service and gave the good wishes of presbytery to the newly united congregation.
